

Domain Name System (DNS) Server Cmdlets in Windows PowerShell

Windows Server 2012 R2 and Windows 8.1

Windows PowerShell® is a task-based command-line shell and scripting language designed especially for system administration. This reference topic for the information technology (IT) professional provides assistance in utilizing the Windows PowerShell cmdlets to script and automate tasks.

Domain Name System (DNS) Server Cmdlets

This reference provides cmdlet descriptions and syntax for all DNS Server cmdlets. It lists the cmdlets in alphabetical order based on the verb at the beginning of the cmdlet.

Cmdlet	Description
Add-DnsServerConditionalForwarderZone	Adds a conditional forwarder to a DNS server.
Add-DnsServerDirectoryPartition	Creates a DNS application directory partition.
Add-DnsServerForwarder	Adds server level forwarders to a DNS server.
Add-DnsServerPrimaryZone	Adds a primary zone to a DNS server.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecord	Adds a resource record of a specified type to a specified DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordA	Adds a type A resource record to a DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordAAAA	Adds a type AAAA resource record to a DNS server.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordCName	Adds a type CNAME resource record to a DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordDnsKey	Adds a type DNSKEY resource record to a DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordDS	Adds a type DS resource record to a DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordMX	Adds an MX resource record to a DNS zone.
Add-DnsServerResourceRecordPtr	Adds a type PTR resource record to a DNS zone.

<u>Add-DnsServerRootHint</u>	Adds root hints on a DNS server.
<u>Add-DnsServerSecondaryZone</u>	Adds a DNS server secondary zone.
<u>Add-DnsServerSigningKey</u>	Adds a KSK or ZSK to a signed zone.
<u>Add-DnsServerStubZone</u>	Adds a DNS stub zone.
<u>Add-DnsServerTrustAnchor</u>	Adds a trust anchor to a DNS server.
<u>Add-DnsServerZoneDelegation</u>	Adds a new delegated DNS zone to an existing zone.
<u>Clear-DnsServerCache</u>	Clears resource records from a cache on the DNS server.
<u>Clear-DnsServerStatistics</u>	Clears all DNS server statistics or statistics for zones.
<u>ConvertTo-DnsServerPrimaryZone</u>	Converts a zone to a DNS primary zone.
<u>ConvertTo-DnsServerSecondaryZone</u>	Converts a primary zone or stub zone to a secondary zone.
<u>Disable-DnsServerSigningKeyRollover</u>	Disables key rollover on an input key.
<u>Enable-DnsServerSigningKeyRollover</u>	Enables rollover on the input key.
<u>Export-DnsServerDnsSecPublicKey</u>	Exports DS and DNSKEY information for a DNSSEC–signed zone.
<u>Export-DnsServerZone</u>	Exports contents of a zone to a file.
<u>Get-DnsServer</u>	Retrieves a DNS server configuration.
<u>Get-DnsServerCache</u>	Gets DNS server cache settings.
<u>Get-DnsServerDiagnostics</u>	Retrieves DNS event logging details.
<u>Get-DnsServerDirectoryPartition</u>	Gets a DNS application directory partition.
<u>Get-DnsServerDnsSecZoneSetting</u>	Gets DNSSEC settings for a zone.
<u>Get-DnsServerDsSetting</u>	Retrieves DNS Server Active Directory settings.
<u>Get-DnsServerEDns</u>	Gets EDNS configuration settings on a DNS sever.
<u>Get-DnsServerForwarder</u>	Gets forwarder configuration settings on a DNS server.
<u>Get-DnsServerGlobalNameZone</u>	Retrieves DNS server GlobalName zone configuration details.
<u>Get-DnsServerGlobalQueryBlockList</u>	Gets a global query block list.
<u>Get-DnsServerRecursion</u>	Retrieves DNS server recursion settings.
<u>Get-DnsServerResourceRecord</u>	Gets resource records from a specified DNS zone.
<u>Get-DnsServerRootHint</u>	Gets root hints on a DNS server.
<u>Get-DnsServerScavenging</u>	Gets DNS aging and scavenging settings.
<u>Get-DnsServerSetting</u>	Retrieves DNS server settings.
<u>Get-DnsServerSigningKey</u>	Gets zone signing keys.
<u>Get-DnsServerStatistics</u>	Retrieves DNS server statistics or statistics for zones.
<u>Get-DnsServerTrustAnchor</u>	Gets trust anchors on a DNS server.
<u>Get-DnsServerTrustPoint</u>	Gets trust points on a DNS server.
<u>Get-DnsServerZone</u>	Gets details of DNS zones on a DNS server.
<u>Get-DnsServerZoneAging</u>	Gets DNS aging settings for a zone.

<u>Get-DnsServerZoneDelegation</u>	Gets the zone delegations of a DNS server zone.
<u>Import-DnsServerResourceRecordDS</u>	Imports DS resource record information from a file.
<u>Import-DnsServerRootHint</u>	Copies root hints from a DNS server.
<u>Import-DnsServerTrustAnchor</u>	Imports a trust anchor for a DNS server.
<u>Invoke-DnsServerSigningKeyRollover</u>	Initiates rollover of signing keys for the zone.
<u>Invoke-DnsServerZoneSign</u>	Signs a DNS server zone.
<u>Invoke-DnsServerZoneUnsign</u>	Unsigns a DNS server zone.
<u>Register-DnsServerDirectoryPartition</u>	Registers a DNS server in a DNS application directory partition.
<u>Remove-DnsServerDirectoryPartition</u>	Removes a DNS application directory partition.
<u>Remove-DnsServerForwarder</u>	Removes server level forwarders from a DNS server.
<u>Remove-DnsServerResourceRecord</u>	Removes specified DNS server resource records from a zone.
<u>Remove-DnsServerRootHint</u>	Removes root hints from a DNS server.
<u>Remove-DnsServerSigningKey</u>	Removes signing keys.
<u>Remove-DnsServerTrustAnchor</u>	Removes a trust anchor from a DNS server.
<u>Remove-DnsServerZone</u>	Removes a zone from a DNS server.
<u>Remove-DnsServerZoneDelegation</u>	Removes a name server or delegation from a DNS zone.
<u>Reset-DnsServerZoneKeyMasterRole</u>	Transfers the role of Key Master for a DNS zone.
<u>Restore-DnsServerPrimaryZone</u>	Restores primary DNS zone contents from Active Directory or from a file.
<u>Restore-DnsServerSecondaryZone</u>	Restores secondary zone information from its source.
<u>Resume-DnsServerZone</u>	Resumes name resolution on a suspended zone.
<u>Set-DnsServer</u>	Overwrites a DNS server configuration.
<u>Set-DnsServerCache</u>	Modifies cache settings for a DNS server.
<u>Set-DnsServerConditionalForwarderZone</u>	Changes settings for a DNS conditional forwarder.
<u>Set-DnsServerDiagnostics</u>	Sets debugging and logging parameters.
<u>Set-DnsServerDnsSecZoneSetting</u>	Changes settings for DNSSEC for a zone.
<u>Set-DnsServerDsSetting</u>	Modifies DNS Active Directory settings.
<u>Set-DnsServerEDns</u>	Changes EDNS settings on a DNS server.
<u>Set-DnsServerForwarder</u>	Changes forwarder settings on a DNS server.
<u>Set-DnsServerGlobalNameZone</u>	Changes configuration settings for a GlobalNames zone.
<u>Set-DnsServerGlobalQueryBlockList</u>	Changes settings of a global query block list.
<u>Set-DnsServerPrimaryZone</u>	Changes settings for a DNS primary zone.
<u>Set-DnsServerRecursion</u>	Modifies recursion settings for a DNS server.
<u>Set-DnsServerResourceRecord</u>	Changes a resource record in a DNS zone.

Set-DnsServerResourceRecordAging	Begins aging of resource records in a specified DNS zone.
Set-DnsServerRootHint	Replaces a list of root hints.
Set-DnsServerScavenging	Changes DNS server scavenging settings.
Set-DnsServerSecondaryZone	Change settings for a DNS secondary zone.
Set-DnsServerSetting	Modifies DNS server settings.
Set-DnsServerSigningKey	Changes settings of a signing key.
Set-DnsServerStubZone	Changes settings for a DNS server stub zone.
Set-DnsServerZoneAging	Configures DNS aging settings for a zone.
Set-DnsServerZoneDelegation	Changes delegation settings for a child zone.
Show-DnsServerCache	Shows the records in a DNS Server Cache.
Show-DnsServerKeyStorageProvider	Returns a list of key storage providers.
Start-DnsServerScavenging	Notifies a DNS server to attempt a search for stale resource records.
Start-DnsServerZoneTransfer	Starts a zone transfer for a secondary DNS zone from master servers.
Step-DnsServerSigningKeyRollover	Rolls over a KSK that is waiting for a parent DS update.
Suspend-DnsServerZone	Suspends a zone on a DNS server.
Sync-DnsServerZone	Checks the DNS server memory for changes, and writes them to persistent storage.
Test-DnsServer	Tests that a specified computer is a functioning DNS server.
Test-DnsServerDnsSecZoneSetting	Validates DNSSEC settings for a zone.
Unregister-DnsServerDirectoryPartition	Deregisters a DNS server from a DNS application directory partition.
Update-DnsServerTrustPoint	Updates all trust points in a DNS trust anchor zone.

To list all the cmdlets that are available, use the `Get-Command -Module DnsServer` cmdlet.
