USMT provides a highly customizable user-profile migration experience for IT professionals. Download the Windows ADK <u>from this website</u>. USMT 5.0 includes three command-line tools:

- ScanState.exe version 6.2
- LoadState.exe version 6.2
- UsmtUtils.exe version 6.2

USMT 5.0 also includes a set of three modifiable .xml files:

- MigApp.xml
- MigDocs.xml
- MigUser.xml

Additionally, you can create custom .xml files to support your migration needs. You can also create a Config.xml file to specify files or settings to exclude from the migration.
