

## ACTIVE DIRECTORY DOMAIN SERVICES GUI (Graphical User Interface) Installation Lab

There are two scenes in this Lab. The scene menu is located on the left Menu bar

- a) **View Scene –Installing AD DS.** In this scene you can view the Lab steps
  - b) The second scene is called the **Try Scene.** The Try Scene is your lab exercise
  - c) Scroll down the left menu bar until you see **Try Scene**
  - d) Click on the link below the **Try Scene** to begin your Lab Exercise

1. Click on Manage
  2. Click on Add Roles and Features
  3. At the Before you Begin screen click on Next
  4. On the Select installation type screen click on Next
  5. On the Select destination server screen click on Next
  6. On the Select Server roles screen click on the check box to the left of Active Directory Domain Services.
  7. Click on Add Features
  8. Click on Next
  9. On the Select features screen click on Next again
  10. Make sure you read the information on the Active Directory Domain Services screen then click on Next to continue
  11. On the Confirm installation selections screen click on Install
  12. On the Installation progress screen select Promote this server to a domain controller
  13. On the Deployment Configuration screen click on Add a new forest
  14. To enter the name of the Domain, on the menu on the left, click on the tab below **Type stdomain.com** then click on Next to continue
  15. Notice the Forest functional level and the Domain functional level. Also note the Domain controller capabilities.
  16. To enter the Directory Services Restore Mode password click the **“Click the \_Next>label”** directly below the second **Type Password02** then click on Next to continue
  17. On the DNS Options screen click Next
  18. On the Additional Options screen click on Next
  19. On the Paths screen click on Next to accept the Default paths
  20. On the Review Options screen click on Next
