

## Lab instruction notes – Creating a virtual hard disk in Server 2012 R2

Note: right click will give you an error box simply click on Try Again to continue

1. Click on Next to begin the lab assignment
2. Click on Tools
3. Click on computer management
4. Click on Disk management
5. Right click on Disk
6. Click on Create VHD
7. Click on Browse
8. Click on 2012R2 E:
9. Click on Antigua VHD
10. Click on Open
11. Click in the File name text box
12. Type classvhd and press Enter
13. Click on Save
14. Click inside the virtual hard disk size box
15. Type 500 and press enter
16. Select VHDX for the virtual Hard Disk format
17. Accept Dynamically expanding and click on OK
18. Right click on Disk 1
19. Select Initialize Disk
20. Accept GPT and click on Ok
21. Right click on your unallocated disk space
22. View the volume options note that all the volumes are grayed out except Simple Volume
