

Creating the IFM folder needed to perform AD DS Install from Media Lab notes

1. Click on Next (bottom right) to begin the Lab  
(Use the on-screen keyboard)
2. Click on the powershell icon on the task bar  to open the powershell prompt
3. Type `ntdsutil` at the prompt then press Enter
4. Type `activate instance ntds` at the ntdsutil prompt
5. Press Enter
6. Type `IFM` at the ntdsutil prompt
7. Press Enter
8. At the ifm prompt type `Create Sysvol Full c:\IFM`
9. Press Enter
10. Click on File folder on the task bar
11. Click on the Local Disk C:
12. Click IFM to open the IFM folder
13. Note the Active Directory, registry and Sysvol folders
